Safety Protocols

- December have 4 cases in 1 class = outbreak and 1 case in another class so 2 classes in isolation for the week prior to the break in December
- change to safety protocols when we do return to school
 - masks mandatory for Grades 1 through 8 and strongly encouraged in Kindergarten
 - students have been wearing masks in our school
- we are continuing with virtual learning announcement didn't include a return date we are acting under the assumption that we are included with the tentative February $10^{\rm th}$
- when students return we will need to be reminding them about social distancing
- staff have taken a refresher course on Covid safety protocols for when we are back in the building

- we have been online since Winter Break
 - we have had high level of engagement with thanks to parents and staff
 - we are grateful to our families for pulling together to ensure that students have access to technology huge shout out to families that helped with devices to make this work
 - Mrs. Humphrey pleased with the independence that her Kindergarten student has while online not so hands on during the meets for the parents, feels empowered to make decisions if he needs to take a break during the meets
- at this point Mrs. Hawthorne is not anticipating any class changes in February, the last time students can shift to DDSB@Home. We will likely remain a school with 5 classes (jk/sk, grade 1/2, 3/4, 5/6 and 7/8)
