Code of Conduct

- The first page the frontage nothing has changed in this section
- Parents nothing changed still active involvements, ensure child is attending, ensuring child is ready for school, working collaboratively with school
- Students nothing changed
- Dress Code this has changed
 - healthy and safety is first and foremost of importance
 - o proper gym shoes for example
 - o clothing free of inappropriate sayings and slogans
 - o families are encouraged to label clothing to avoid getting lost
 - kids can wear hats and hoods as long as face is visible this is nice allows self expression and save teachers from fighting over the issue
- Next area talk about Lockers this year is just coats and boots (storing of outdoor clothing), so no locks needed
- Consequences of Inappropriate Behaviour
 - Progressive discipline
 - Posters reminding students Own It, Fix It. Learn From It, Move On
 - End goals of discipline is for students to learn how to make safe choices
 - Focus on telling the truth being honest can change the consequences because the behaviour was owned
 - Change Students K-3 are no longer allowed to be suspended
- Phones
 - Ministry ruling not to be at school but there are times when they are necessary such as school closures and reaching out to families
 - Problem comes from snapping pics or recording videos sharing/posting can be highly problematic
